SPL will unroll updates to the Becky's Garden web page with more educational information about each plant.





In 2023, Syracuse Public Library hosted **388 programs**, which were attended by **4,603 participants**. The same year the library checked out **78,699 items**, including **47,027 books**, **9,466 DVDs**, **984 CD audiobooks**, and **241 hotspots**! On the digital side (Libby and Hoopla apps), there were **9,196 e-books**, **7,567 e-audiobooks**, and **298 videos** checked out.


A powerful story of friendship, it is also about the power of reading, the price of betrayal, and the possibility of redemption; and an
